Literacy

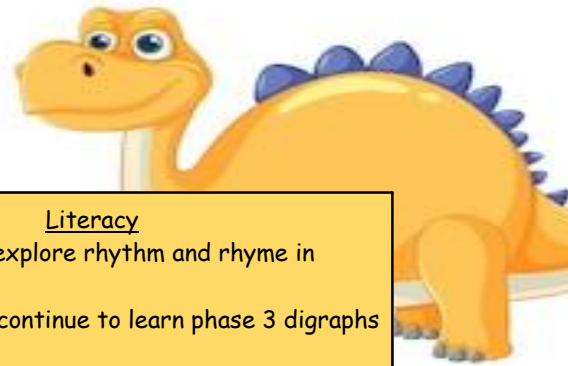
FS1 children will explore rhythm and rhyme in phonics.

The children will be taking part in yoga lessons this half term.

The children will continue to develop their physical skills outside through riding scooters and bikes, skipping, hopping and jumping and completing ring games.

The children will continue to develop fine motor skills through story dough, dough disco and fun writing skills.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Lifewise units on managing feelings, sleep, the great outdoors and trusted adults.

The children will be learning about e-safety through story.

Talking about what is personal information and who not to share it with.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be completing observational drawings, self-portraits in black and white and in colour.

The children will explore colour mixing and naming a range of colours.

The children will be exploring finger painting, large scale and small scale art work and group art work.

Understanding of the World

We will continue to observe the seasonal changes in winter, looking closely at our special tree in the woodland area.

The children will investigate dinosaurs through a range of explorative activities, thinking about questions they might want to ask and find the answer to.

Learning about different types of dinosaur and learning new vocabulary such as herbivore and carnivore.

Communication and Language

The children will be talking about dinosaurs and exploring being a palaeontologist through the dinosaur explorer role play area.

The children will explore dinosaurs through stories and investigations in the classroom.
