PE day is a Friday again this term.

FS1 (nursery) and FS2 (Reception) children are all going to be doing gymnastics this half term. As last half term, FS1 children will take their shoes and socks off for PE and FS2 children will be putting their PE kits on.

This term we will be continuing to encourage the children to become independent when dressing and undressing for PE. If they are practising getting ready at home themselves, this will support them with this in school.

Please ensure all elements of PE kit and uniform has your child's name in.

This term we are focussing on putting on coats and zipping them up. Please practise this with your child so they can become independent.

What We Are Learning

Our topic this term is **'Twinkle twinkle little star!'** We are going to be learning about space and exploring constellations, planets, the moon, comets, aliens and rockets during the term. The children will be having fun in our space station role play area as well as rocket counting in maths. They are going to be completing a DT project on making rainbow salad. The children will be baking some delicious space-related treats over the half term including constellation cookies, blast off breakfasts, moon rice cakes and space rock cakes.

FS2 children will be revisiting all sounds covered so far and learning more complex tricky words. Please read with your child as much as possible to increase their confidence. Keep persevering with the red book words! The children are making real progress with these!

FS1 children are going to be doing lots of work on alliteration this half term and continuing their understanding of rhythm and rhyme too.
