Music

- Learn to play the recorder and play simple a song

Science

Properties of materials and states of matter
Children will answer the following questions:

- Solid, liquid or gas?
- Exploring materials (hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivity)
- Do all materials fall through water the same way?
- How can I group materials?
- How can mixtures be separated? (sieving)
- How can mixtures be separated? (filtering)
- How can mixtures be separated? (evaporating)
- Which material is best for a fence? (metal/wood)

Computing

E-Safety –Online reputation, self-image and identity

- Explore online presence and that information about people online can be used to make judgements about people
- Understand how to make sensible choices about online content and what they share with other
- Know they should not share things online about others without permission.

Flat- File database

- Organise data in records.
- Use tools within a database to order and answer questions about data.
- Create graphs and charts from their data to help solve problems.
- Use a real-life database to answer a question, and present their work to others.
