



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Communication and Language

 The children will be taking part in gymnastics lessons this half term. The children will continue to develop their physical skills outside through riding scooters and bikes, skipping, hopping and jumping and completing ring games. The children will continue to develop fine motor skills through story dough, dough disco and fun writing skills.

Literacy
 FS1 children will explore rhythm and rhyme in phonics.
 FS2 children will continue to learn phase 3 digraphs in phonics.
 Reading and writing activities around fairy tales.
 FS2 continue to develop their writing skills and learning the components of a sentence.
 FS1 children continue to recognise their name.

Expressive Arts and Design
 The children will be completing observational drawings, self-portraits in black and white and in colour. The children will explore colour mixing and naming a range of colours. The children will be exploring finger painting, large scale and small scale art work and group art work.

Understanding of the World
 We will continue to observe the seasonal changes in winter, looking closely at our special tree in the woodland area.
 Look at pictures of now and the past.
 Beebots work in computing.
 Continue e-safety work through stories.

Mathematics
 Naming and ordering days of the week.
 Continue counting to 20.
 Becoming more confident with number pairs that make 5 and then 10.
 Looking closely and talking about 2D and 3D shapes.
