5<sup>th</sup> February FS2 (reception/ladybirds) parents invited into school for Fairy tales morning

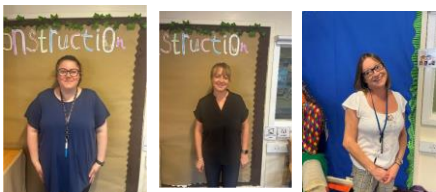
Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> February whole school careers assembly
