Expressive Arts and Design

Outdoor art using natural resources.
Making marks intentionally such as 'it says my name.'
Notice patterns in the environment.

Mathematics

Helping with sorting in the new hall and knowing where the resources stay.
Body percussion rhythms such as clapping and stamping.
Using vocabulary 'lots' and 'a few' in play.
Looking at number 2 and 3 for our ages.
Counting rhymes.

Literacy

Focus texts: The Gruffalo, We're going on a Bear Hunt and The Cave.
Enjoy sharing books with an adult.
Pay attention to pictures and words in books.
Choose a favourite book to share or read alone.

Woodland area exploration.
Exploring natural materials, indoors and outdoors.

What would it be like to move in swishy swashy grass, a snowstorm, oozy mud or a cold river?
