Practising moving to music.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Building confidence to play with others.
Become increasingly confident in the pre-school with the key worker and their peers.

Communication and Language

Build on vocabulary we already know.
Begin to communicate with others more using gestures and words.
Understand frequently used words like 'bye-bye' and 'hello.'

Expressive Arts and Design

Making sounds and repetitive sounds using body percussion, voices and instruments.
Make sound makers.
Explore paint using different parts of our body including finger painting.

Mathematics

Begin to take part in number rhymes.
Noticing shapes around us.
Spatial awareness: climbing inside boxes and through tunnels.

Literacy

Children will be encouraged to join in with songs and rhymes.
Begin to learn action songs like 'Head, shoulders, knees and toes.'

Notice differences between ourselves and others.
Talk about what we like and dislike.
What super powers do we have?
Talk about who we live with.
