 Learn new Vocabulary linked to the texts.

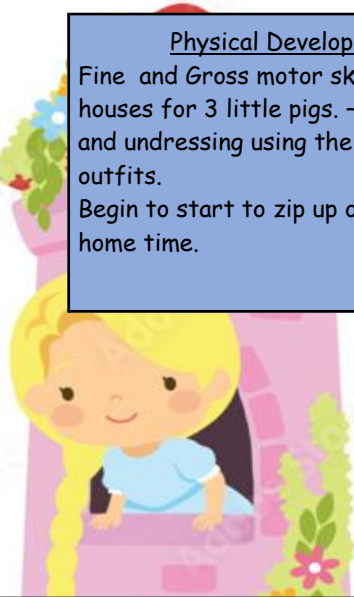
Physical Development

 Begin to start to zip up own coat at home time.



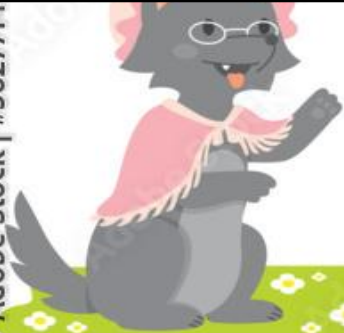
Expressive Arts and Design

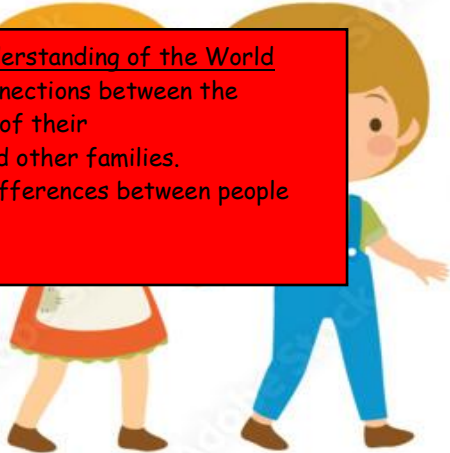
Literacy
