Water bottles

Please ensure that your child has a water bottle in school every day. **Please remember that it must be just water in the bottle and not juice.**

Supporting your child at home

Encourage use of useful websites on the school website under children/useful websites KS1. Helping your child with counting to and back from 100 and encouraging them to write at home; helping write shopping lists or notes for people. We will go through some ideas to support with phonics at the meeting on Friday, too. If you can do anything please continue to read little and often with your child, even 5-10 minutes per night! Read a page each to give confidence if needed.
