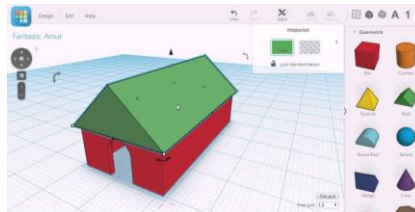
Science

In Science we will be continuing to learn about Sound and Light but we will focus on Light. This will include understanding how we actually see and how shadows are made!



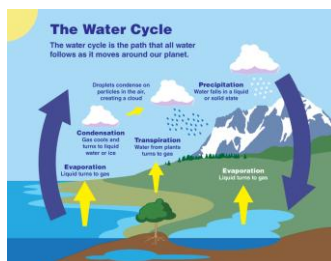
Computing
