

Communication and Language

Learning new vocabulary linked to under the sea and the importance of taking your litter home at the beach.

Children will be encouraged to use their words and be polite with each other and the grown ups in the classroom. Learning to use talk to express themselves, share ideas and take turns in conversations.

We will be playing 'what if...?' games with the children and talking about where we might go if we travelled across the sea.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be looking at seaside paintings and comparing them. They will talk about what they like and dislike and make their own.

The children will be refining their cutting skills, threading skills, joining materials, making paper snakes and tissue flowers.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Lifewise units on learning to sharing, technology and marching to the beat of your own drum.

We are also going to learn about money, what it is and why it is important.

Understanding of the World

We will observe the seasonal changes leading to summer, looking closely at our special tree in the woodland area.

The children will investigate what animals live under the sea and animals that live at the seaside.

They will think carefully about how we can look after our beaches and the animals that live there.

Mathematics

Our areas of learning in maths each term are:

- Sets and sorting
- Pattern and regularity
- counting and number sense
- Number operations
- Spatial relationships
- Measurement
- Shape
- Data analysis

The children cover all areas over the half term and revisit each term to build up a secure mathematical knowledge.

Literacy

FS1 children will continue to practise oral blending in phonics. They will continue to find and write their name. They will continue to practice syllable clapping and rhyming strings.

FS2 children will begin phase 5 phonics, learning new sounds. They will be practising reading and spelling harder to read and spell words and putting these in sentences. The children will be writing messages in bottles and drawing and writing treasure maps.

Physical Development

The children will be taking part in athletics and sports day practise this term. Lots of running, jumping and throwing practise. The daily mile will continue on the field and we will be looking at running progress and challenging ourselves in PE.

Everyone will be getting changed for PE and practising their independence skills for September.
