#### 1) Weekly Attendance update

Below are the individual class attendance figures for last week. The Government expectation is 96% and this should be the minimum that we are all aiming for this year!!

Last week we had only 2 classes above 96% which is the national expectation. The average attendance from Y1-Y6 was 93.2% which is below the 96% national expectation.

#### 2) Trespass in the school yard over the weekend

Unfortunately, we have had some trespassing in the yard over the weekend (Sunday) with 3 youths spotted in the yard by our CCTV monitoring company which resulted in a call out by our security company.

I am aware that the community site is a busy place over a weekend with the play park and the football areas. If any parents / carers or members of the community have seen anything or heard anything, please could you let one of my team or I know. This matter is being looked into today to see if anything needs to be reported to the police.

#### 3) <u>PE kit</u>

With the warmer weather, our PE sessions are now taking place outdoors wherever possible. Please can I ask that all children have a full kit for PE (shorts, t-shirts, jogging pants and trainers / sandshoes) to enable them to take part. If children forget their PE kit on that day, we will continue to ring home and ask for PE kit to be brought into school to enable them to take part fully. We also have spare PE kit in school for children to change into to enable them to participate fully in this statutory part of their curriculum. #### 4) Uniform

I appreciate that we are heading towards the final part of the current academic year. However, with the final half term still being 7 weeks long, we still need to maintain our agreed school uniform, **including black shoes** and PE kit.

We have a group of children coming into school wearing leggings/tracksuit bottoms instead of the school uniform of grey or black skirt or black or grey trousers. This includes leggings / tracksuit bottoms with brand names and logos down the side of them. These are not part of our agreed school uniform. I would appreciate full parental support in ensuring that children are wearing the correct uniform below during the remainder of the summer term.

We do have some good quality, pre-loved uniform and some black shoes in a range of sizes in school. Please contact the school office or Mrs Liddle if you need a few bits and pieces to support the final part of the summer term.

Please can I ask for your full support with our agreed school uniform? Phone calls home will continue to be made where children are not in the right uniform. Many thanks.

#### 5) Black Shoes and sandals

After the half term holidays and with the warmer weather, we are happy to slightly relax the shoe colour rule to enable children to <u>wear sandals</u> if they choose to. May we remind parents that these should be a suitable dark colour (black if possible) and height (no high heels or bright colours).

If your child is not wearing the slight changes to the rules to accommodate sandals for the





















warmer weather, then they <u>must wear black shoes</u> for school as this is part of our uniform expectations.

# 6) Year 2 SATs (End of Key Stage 1)

Our Year 2 children have worked very hard for the last 2 week doing their reading and maths end of Key Stage 1 SATs. They have all worked extremely hard and I am sure they will all have achieved their best. Well done Year 2!!! You were all amazing!!!

#### 7) School Uniform Swap Shop and last week of summer term non-uniform
