1) Weekly Attendance update

Please can I ask for your full support with our agreed school uniform? We appreciate that children grow out of clothes and shoes and that half term is approaching to double check uniform and shoes.

After half term, phone calls home will be made by my team and I where children are not in the right uniform, e.g black shoes. Many thanks.
