

Seesaw

What is Seesaw?

Seesaw is an online journal where teachers can keep examples of learning. When you create your Seesaw account you will then have access to your child's journal so that this learning can be shared at home.

How do I get a Seesaw account?

You will receive your child's unique QR code from you're their class teacher. Once you have this you simply download the Seesaw Parent Access app onto your tablet, phone or other mobile device or access the seesaw.me website and follow the registration instructions (these are also on the QR code hand out).

Once you have registered you will have access to your child's account. You can download the app onto more than 1 device and more than one person can create an account, for example, grandparents might want access.

What can I do with the account?

You child's class teacher will regularly post examples of learning onto your child's account such as photographs and videos.

When a teacher posts onto your child's account you will receive a notification. You can then look at the work and have the option to 'like' it.
