Dear Parents / Carers

A lovely first full week in school which saw a fire safety visit in our Year 4 class and British Sign Language (BSL) sessions with our Y4, Y5 and Y6 classes on Friday. Well done!!

#### 1) Weekly Attendance update

Below are the individual class attendance figures for last week. The Government expectation is 96% and this should be the minimum that we are all aiming for this year!!

#### Attendance for Monday 11<sup>th</sup> September – Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September

Last week we had 2 classes above 96% which is the national expectation both with 100% attendance – well done Year 2 and Year 3. The average attendance from Y1-Y6 was 94.7% which is well below the 96% national expectation. This is mainly due to the holidays outside of term time which took place last week. Hopefully we can see an improvement to above 96% next week across all classes.

# 4) Online gaming workshop for parents / carers

- Understanding in-game currencies, the dangers associated and how to prevent payment/card details being retained unexpectedly.

The workshop will be held on Tuesday 26th September at 9am in school. It will last up to 2 hours and this includes time for questions. These workshops are free.
