Dear Parents / Carers

A lovely week in school which saw our Early Years Foundation Stage children visiting Seaton Deleval Hall on Thursday for a delightful outdoor trip. It was wonderful to see our youngest children exploring the outdoors, learning, having fun and behaving impeccably. Well done Early Years!

1) Weekly Attendance update

Below are the individual class attendance figures for last week. The Government expectation is 96% and this should be the minimum that we are all aiming for this year!!

Last week we had 2 classes above 96% which is the national expectation. Our Year 2 class had 100% attendance – well done Y2! The average attendance from Y1-Y6 was 94.2% which is well below the 96% national expectation. We continue to see an impact on attendance figures due to holidays outside of term time alongside a sickness bug.

Unfortunately, we have not had a great start to the year with attendance. Hopefully things improve rapidly across October as we run up to parents / carers evenings and half term.

2) Parent / Teacher Nights

Our autumn term parent / teacher evenings are scheduled for Tuesday 10th October and Wednesday 11th October. Please find below the procedures that we have put in place for our face to face parents / carers evenings this week.

• Our autumn term appointments are 10 minute appointments and will be strictly adhered to. This is to ensure staff are running on time and that we reduce congestion in our corridors. If additional time is required, staff will be in touch at a later date to arrange a further telephone appointment.



- Parents / carers are politely requested to only arrive at school 5 minutes before their appointment time. This is to give time for you to look at your child's books and the curriculum learning they have completed and to reduce congestion in our corridors.
- If you need to bring your child / children with you for your appointment time, they must remain next to you in the corridor at all times. This includes going into the appointment with you they cannot wait in the corridor area outside the classroom.
- <u>Meetings will take place in your child's classroom with the layout decided by the</u> individual class teacher. At the end of your appointment, you will be asked to exit the classroom via the external doors into the school yard to leave. The only exception will be for those who have siblings and need to go back into the corridor for their next appointment and year 6 parents / carers who will leave by the top external door. This is to reduce congestion in the corridor and to support keeping appointments on time for parents / carers and staff.

3) Sports Crew Raffle

Sports Crew have been working very hard over the last few weeks increasing fitness with our Daily Fitness Challenges and Fitness Activities at break and lunchtime.

We would like to run a sports raffle to raise money for the playground equipment. Raffle tickets will be on sale from Monday 23rd October until Thursday 26th October.
