1) Weekly Attendance update

Attendance for Monday 23rd October – Thursday 26th October

Last week we had 4 classes above 96% which is the national expectation. The average attendance from Y1-Y6 was 97.1% which is above the 96% national expectation. A much better week for attendance. Let's hope this continues over the 2nd half of Autumn.
