Dear Parents / Carers

A very busy first week back with all children returning to school very settled and ready to learn. Our Y1 and Y2 classes were visited by Gosforth Nature reserve on Wednesday and completed some focused learning tasks in school. Well done Key Stage 1!

1) Weekly Attendance update

Below are the individual class attendance figures for last week. The Government expectation is 96% and this should be the minimum that we are all aiming for this year!!

Last week we only had 2 classes above 96% which is the national expectation. The average attendance from Y1-Y6 was 93.9% which is well below the 96% national expectation. I will be looking closely at year group and individual attendance this week to see if we have any patterns.


5) FS1 (Nursery) Places

6) End of Autumn Term Attendance

A reminder that at the end of this term, parents / carers of children from FS2 (Reception) to Year 6 will receive their child's current attendance percentage to date and which colour zone your child is in for their attendance - Green, Amber or Red.



Danger Zone ~ inadequate attendance ~ 90% or less = Red

At Risk Zone ~ attendance that requires improvement ~ **between 90.1%** and **95.9%** = Amber

Safety Zone ~ good attendance ~ 96% or more = Green

The Government expects attendance of 96% or above. It is fantastic if your child is in the green zone (safety zone)!!!

If your child's attendance is in the amber zone (at risk zone), their attendance is below the standard set by the Government. As a school, we will look at ways to support you to improve your child's attendance including a period of attendance monitoring. We are also aware that there has been a sickness bug in school that your child may well have caught.

If your child's attendance is in the red zone (Danger Zone), your child's attendance may be referred through the Local Authority Fast Track system to the Education Welfare Officer. Having 90% attendance means that your child is absent from school on average half a day each week. Miss Hunter will be in contact with you to discuss your child's attendance and to see if there is anything the school can do to support you to improve
