Dear Parents / Carers

Last week was very busy with some classes out on visits. On Tuesday, Mrs Baty took a group of KS2 pupils to a Boccia competition at Walker Activity Dome. On a very cold Thursday, our Year 3 class visited Segedunum Roman Fort and Museum to support their 'Romans' history topic. Then on Friday, our Year 2 class visited Newcastle Cathedral linked to their RE unit of work.

## 1) Weekly Attendance update
