Under the Equality Act 2010, schools are required to publish equality information and analysis for staff and service users on an annual basis. This needs to be done by 30th April every year.

Equality Information for Burradon Community Primary School – February 2024

- **175 pupils on role**
- **92 are female and 83 are male**
- **We have a FSM uptake of 41%**
- **8% of our pupils are from an ethnic minority background**
- **Most children are White British origin**
- **Most children in the school have no faith.**

Publishing Equality Impact Assessments (EIA's)¹

There is the requirement to publish the details of the EIA's you have undertaken regarding policies and practices in your school. This is in order to demonstrate the following;

- analysis to establish whether your policies and practices further the aims of the equality duty
- any information you considered when undertaking that analysis
- details of engagement with interested parties concerning fulfilling the equality duty

Pupil information

Schools should monitor the composition of pupils and their experiences of the schools' services on an annual basis. The results of this monitoring should be analysed and interpreted so that it can be used to identify actions that can be taken to advance equality and good relations.
