Spotlight on SEND PENCIL LETTERS

In our school, we have a sheet which looks like this:



It is called the pencil letter due to all of the pencils!

This letter is shared with parents / carers when staff in agreement with Miss Hunter and I believe your child would benefit from additional support. This additional support may include extra reading, phonics booster, fine or gross motor intervention as well as maths intervention or handwriting intervention. It will list all the additional support your child will receive in school.

We closely monitor in school the impact of the additional support. When your child is not receiving an intervention/support anymore, the class teacher will contact you to let you know. This may because your child has made progress, or we feel the intervention is not making the impact required and wish to explore another route.

As well as sharing additional support a child may receive, the pencil letter may also ask your permission to place your child on our Monitoring Register or SEND Support Register. These registers allow us to closely monitor children who are receiving support or children who have a diagnosis such as Autism, ADHD as well as children who are receiving Speech and Language interventions.

Some children will not have a pencil letter as they have SEND Support Plan. Please read our next newsletter to find out more about this.
